1. Job title and number of available positions: One associate professor

#### 3. **Job description:**

The successful applicant is expected to have a strong background and excellent research activities in the theoretical studies of condensed matter physics, statistical physics or quantum information. The applicant is expected to conduct research as a PI and teach at both graduate and undergraduate levels in the University of Tokyo.
